Lower Green River Flood Hazard Management Plan - Inundation Map King County Flood Control District

Find address or place

Use the **Search** bar to find an address or place on the map.

Use the **Information** button to navigate to this How-To Guide or the SEPA Scoping website.

The **+/-** buttons adjust the zoom level.

The **Home** button will take you back to the original map extent.

The **Locator** button will prompt a pop-up window that asks permission to use your current location; if granted, your location will be shown on the map.

Use the **Layer List** button to see all available layers and toggle their visibility by checking them on/off.

Click the **Legend** button to see the symbology of all visible map layers.

The "Inundation from 500-year flood" map layer is shown at the neighborhood level with limited resolution. It is not visible at the parcel level. Depth is measured in feet from 0 feet (lighter) to 41 feet (darker).
